Delq A/R Debt File Interface:

Although SAL allows for Delq A/R Debts to be posted manually, our Delq A/R Debt Interface will allow us to transfer and balance all of your New Delq A/R Debts, and/or Adjustments from the University's Financial Aid System to SAL within minutes.

File Layout Requirements:

ECSI's Standard Delq A/R Debt File Layout Requirements may be found on the following page and our preferred file format is Flat ASCII, Fixed Length, Line Sequential.

Please Note: To facilitate automation, ECSI is willing to accept the University's Delq A/R Debt File(s) in any file layout and format (including your current file layout and format, if applicable) to relieve your administrative and IT workload. Once developed, this file layout must be used in all future Delq A/R Debt interface files. *If using your own layout, or if your existing layout requires changes, please arrange testing and programming by email notification to implementation@ecsi.net.

Frequency:

The University may transmit it's Delq A/R Debt Files to ECSI as often as desired.



Method of Data Transfer:

For security purposes, ECSI strongly encourages it's clients to transmit data files via the ECSI File Transfer Service. This free software will Encrypt, and transmit via Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP). Other methods that are supported include SFTP without encryption, and PGP encryption via FTP or SFTP transfer. To aid in automating interface file transfers, ECSI can arrange Public Key authentication to our File Transfer Service. Once your Delq A/R Debt Interface File has been transferred, please send us a courtesy email to <u>operations@ecsi.net</u> to let us know that a file has been sent. Please make sure to include the dollar total expected from the Delq A/R Debts in the file. Once your Delq A/R Debt File has been processed, you will receive an automatic courtesy email notification as confirmation.
